Message from the Chair

Welcome to Fleet and District U3A. We are part of a national organisation of U3As, affiliated to the Third Age Trust, where local groups like ours provide opportunities for older adults to come together to develop their existing interests and to learn new skills. We don't study for qualifications; we just enjoy taking part and making new friends.

The 'Third Age' comes from a French idea, where the First Age is your childhood and education, the Second Age is your working life and bringing up children and the Third Age is where you make the most of your leisure time, have fun and help others.

Fleet U3A was formed in 1994 and we have grown into one of the largest U3As in the country. We are all volunteers. We share our knowledge and expertise with fellow members in the certain knowledge that we will benefit from others' skills and experience in other fields. Let us know if you have a skill you would like to share or an interest you would like to develop with like-minded people.

Most groups meet in the daytime during the working week. We mostly keep to school terms. During the Covid-19 pandemic our programme of physical meetings and events was suspended although most groups continued to meet regularly in the virtual world. This shows the dedication and commitment of our members to supporting each other. We look forward to returning to full working order as soon as possible although we are anticipating a mixed economy of some physical and some virtual meetings and sometimes a blend of the two, Wi-Fi permitting. There is usually an attendance charge for each session and sometimes additional charges for professional tutors, trips, external speakers or materials. There is a Monthly Meeting with refreshments and a guest speaker on the third Wednesday in the month, regular new-member coffee meetings, an Open Morning in April and our AGM in November.

Fleet U3A has charity status and is governed by a hard-working and dedicated committee which meets monthly. It is a big job to manage an organisation as large as ours so we are always on the lookout for help.

PROCESS FOR JOINING A GROUP

Group Enrolment Day is organised so that members can join the group(s) of their choice. When joining a group, the leader will first need to see your **current** membership card and will then add your name and contact information to the register. **ALL YOU THEN NEED TO DO IS TURN UP ON THE RELEVANT DATES.** Please always be sure to inform your group leader(s) AND the membership secretary (memsec@fleetu3a.org.uk) if you change your phone number and/or e-mail address.

If you cannot attend Enrolment Day, please contact the Group Leader of the group(s) you wish to join **before** attending a meeting. All the dates for group meetings are shown in this programme. All you need to do, after you have enrolled with the Group Leader, is turn up on the dates shown.

When you attend your first meeting, you must show the Group Leader your **current** membership card. It is recommended that both sides be completed to show ICE (in case of emergency) details. **(Please Note: It is not accepted practice to 'turn up' at a group meeting without first registering with the Group Leader; all contact details are included in this programme).**

Carers accompanying members are welcomed free of charge at meetings.


